We organize YEARLY EVENTS that include an annual caucus in January/February to elect delegates/alternates to the **State Convention**. In even numbered years convention delegates will endorse candidates for statewide office.

A **Regional Spring Unity Brunch is a premier political event** in Attleboro that attracts both state and Congressional elected leaders.
